CRIB SAFETY

✓ DO:

- ~ Baby on back
- ~ Firm crib mattress
- ~ Fitted sheets
- ~ Share a room, not a bed



✗ DON'T:

- ~ Crib bumpers
- ~ Blankets
- ~ Pillows
- ~ Stuffed animals
- ~ Cords near crib
- ~ Sleep wedges

DROWNING PREVENTION

- ~ Watch your child closely when they are near any water
- ~ Do not walk away, or get distracted by your phone when child is in or near water
- ~ Security fence around pool
- ~ Install an alarm on the door leading to the pool
- ~ Stay away from drains
- ~ Teach children to swim early
- ~ Learn CPR



Drowning is silent and only takes a minute.

SUICIDE PREVENTION

A 2019 Youth Risk Behavior Survey of all high school students in Nye, Esmeralda and Lincoln Counties reflected that 21.1% of students had seriously considered suicide in the 12 months prior to the survey.



Risk Factors:

- ~ Mental Illness
- ~ Substance Misuse
- ~ Firearms in the home
- ~ Self-harm
- ~ Exposure to suicide of someone close to them
- ~ Low self-esteem

Some Protective Factors:

- ~ Family and School connections
- ~ Safe school environment
- ~ Reduced access to firearms
- ~ Academic achievement
- ~ Self Esteem
