- Application assistance
- Pre-determining eligibility for public programs
- Caregiver support and connection to respite care services
- Consumer advocacy
- Resources and supports to meet long-term goals
- Case management for those who have:
  - o Dementia or have memory loss that hinders their ability to maintain services long term
  - Hearing loss or a speech disability that hinders their ability to maintain services long term
