Nevada Care Connection Resource Centers provide assistance to older adults, individuals with disabilities, caregivers, veterans, and families, regardless of income or age, access long-term services and supports available in the community.

Our Resource Navigators offer a wide-ranging support to help individual identify needs and goals, and explore their options. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Application assistance
- Pre-determination of eligibility for public programs
- Caregiver support and connection to respite care services
- Advocacy
- Resources and support to meet long-term goals
- Case management for those who have:
  - Dementia or memory loss that hinders their ability to maintain services long term
  - Hearing loss or a speech disability and are having difficulties obtaining or maintaining long-term supportive services
